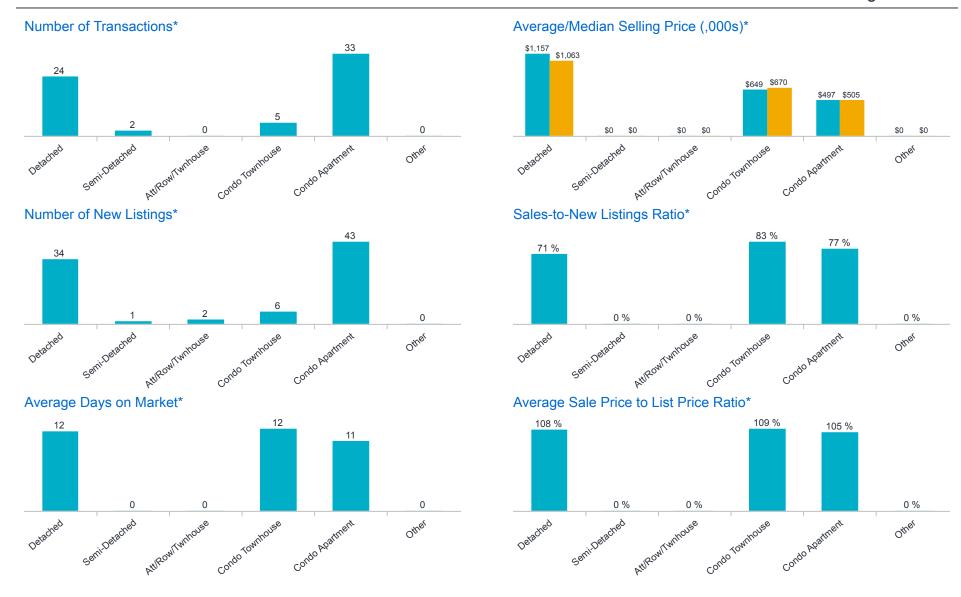

Second Quarter 2021 Toronto E10: West Hill



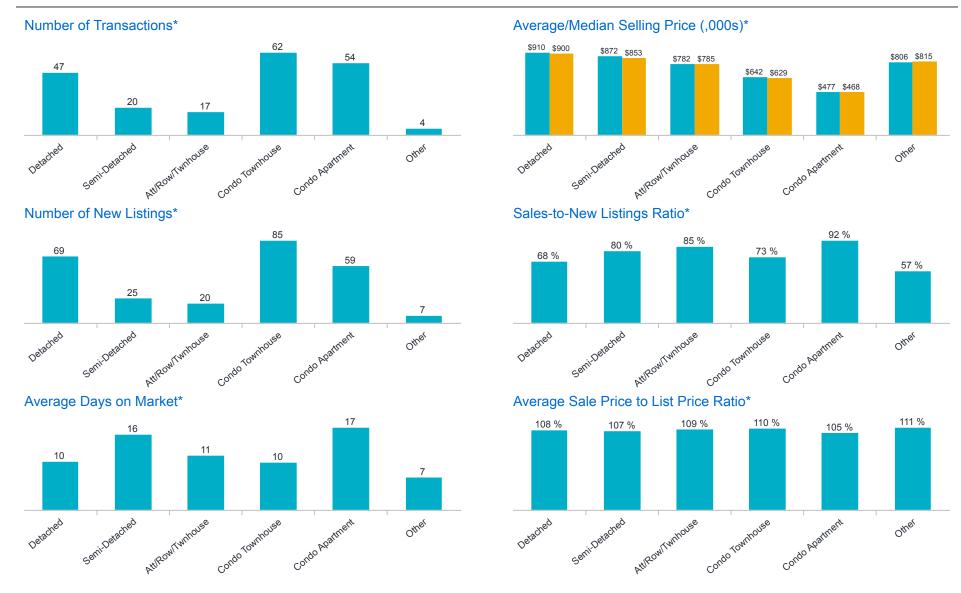

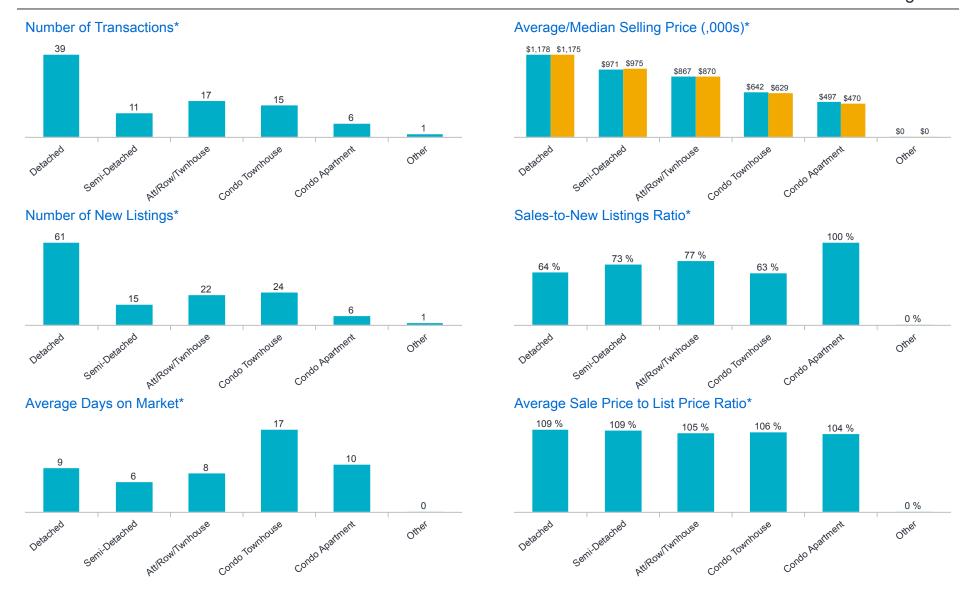
